

Letter 12: March 1518, [Basel], Capito to Bruno Amerbach

[Summary]: Capito asks Amerbach to obtain for him [at the Frankfurt book fair] the pages missing from his copy of Sophocles, and to buy for him a Greek Bible. Capito will reimburse him, or, perhaps Adam Petri will donate them. He also asks Amerbach to buy Hebrew books other than the Bible and Agostino Giustiniani's *Psalterium*. Capito plans to study Hebrew together with Bruno during the summer. In the postscript he asks Johann Froben to send Oecolampadius a copy of Capito's *Hebraicarum Institutionum libri duo*.
