

Letter 20: Fall 1518, [Basel], Capito to Bruno Amerbach

[Summary]: Capito's servant is gravely ill. Some think that it is the plague, but Capito thinks otherwise since the servant does not have any of the symptoms and complains only of a headache. Capito warns Amerbach not to visit him until the threat of contagion is past.
